This works for the following phone companies: ATT/SBC, Verizon, Windstream/Alltel

For ATT/SBC, you MUST add "@netlink.net" to your username (ie., <u>example@netlink.net</u>)

If your area code is 740, and Verizon is your phone provider, you do not need this guide. Once you have everything hooked up, simply open up a web browser such as Internet Explorer, and it should work
